Panel Project 2024

Building on, and learning from, the two NIPA panel projects run in 2021 to 2023, NIPA has launched a Panel project for 2024. As before, this is not a competition. Submit a panel of 10-12 PDI images with a short narrative. Images used should preferably be taken between 1st January 2024 and 27th of November 2024. The panels and narratives will be shown and described at an on-line event (Exhibition) on Monday 2nd Dec 2024, Each club will present its images and panel on the night. There should be a minimum participation of 5 photographers per club unless this is impossible for a specific reason.

Panel Subjects as in previous years are encouraged to be related to the catchment area of the club if possible, or to a topic the club is passionate about, but clubs have the freedom as in previous years to choose any other topic or genre they wish. The duration within a calendar year and PDI format is to allow inclusion of the summer in the Panel year and no burden of print preparation on clubs.


The main objective of the project is for Clubs to have fun doing their panels for all to enjoy in the exhibition. This was certainly the case in the previous two projects!
